



Mark your Buddies' gear with a

Paw Print Potato Stamp!

Potato stamps are a fun way to mark and decorate personal items. Here's how you can make your own potato stamp in the shape of a paw print to mark different items for your favorite furry friend.



Adult Supervision Required

YOU WILL NEED:

- Potato (washed)
- Sharp knife (to be used by an adult)
- Non-toxic black paint (acrylic works well on fabric)
- Flat shallow dish or lid (for paint stamp pad)
- Scrap paper (for testing)
- The item you wish to stamp

TO MAKE:

Adult's part: 1) Carefully cut the potato in half. 2) Carve the outline of the paw shape into the flat face of the potato. 3) Cut away the potato surrounding the paw print so that the shape protrudes about a 1/4 inch (.5cm).

Kid's part: 4) Spread a thin layer of paint evenly on a flat dish or lid. 5) Press your potato stamp down into the paint to "ink" your stamp. You're ready to start stamping! For best results test your stamp out on your scrap paper until you like the way it looks.

Simple shapes like stars, hearts and dog bones are the best choice for this kind of stamp.
